Locker Rooms:

No locker rooms will be provided for this event. Phil Welch stadium is not affiliated with the SJSD and is a city owned stadium.

Game Balls:

Each team shall supply, at a minimum, 4 top-grade baseballs for each game they participate in. Please be advised that 4 baseballs will probably not get you through a game with the number of foul balls that either end up behind the stadium or in the parking lot. I would suggest a “ball shagger” from each team to run down foul balls.

National Anthem:

This will only be played before the first game of each day. Teams are asked to line up on their respective baselines for the anthem. At no time at the conclusion of the anthem, may teams participate in an “National Anthem Standoff” This is grounds for immediate ejection from the game.

Home / Visitor Teams and Dugout information:

The higher seeded team of each game shall have the choice of being home or visitor. Any game that Lafayette is playing, they will be in the 3rd base dugout. For any other games that Lafayette is not involved in, the higher seed will use the 3rd base dugout and the lower seed will use the 1st base dugout.

Warm-Up Procedures:

Warm-ups shall begin 35 minutes prior to the start of game one on each day (10:25 / 3:55 / 5:25). The higher seeded team will begin its warm up at that 35 minute mark and not to exceed 15 minutes. The lower seeded team will begin its warm-ups directly after, not exceeding 15 minutes. At the conclusion of each teams warm-ups, they will return to their respective dugout until starting line-ups are announced.
